

Class Configuration

From the main menu, by going to Activity Communication and then Default Class Settings you can define class details which will allow SwimSoft to auto-complete many elements of your course for you. When you set the class type in a course, you will automatically be setting the maximum and the minimum number of clients that the course should have, as well as the syllabus the clients will be taught, and any additional awards instructors can issue.

What data do we store?

Class Name	The name of the class i.e., Stage 1, Level 1, Minnows.
Duration (mins)	The duration of a class in minutes.
Previous Class Level	The previous class the student completed and progressed from.
Next Class Level	The name of the class the student will progress to after successful completion.
Max Class Size	The ideal or maximum number of students you wish to have in a class.
Min Class Size	The minimum number of students it is viable to run the course with.
Syllabus Required	If you do not plan to allow your instructors to work with any given syllabus, this box should be unchecked.
Number of Syllabi	The number of syllabi you have defined for the class type (automatically calculated).
Awards Required	If you do not want to allow your instructors to issue any additional awards, this box should be unchecked.
Number of Awards	The number of awards you are allowing your instructors to issue in addition to the main syllabi (automatically calculated).

Subsections

The classes page has two subsections where you set the classes default Syllabi and Additional award information.
