Lesson Manager Enhanced

The latest version of Lesson Manager has been enhanced so that 'Awards' are now issued from poolside (the device) when all the related tasks are passed, meaning it's no longer necessary to log into SwimSoft Online to 'pass' (issue) awards if you don't plan to write a comment / give feedback. As part of this project, we have also given swim schools the option to issue 'Linked' awards, meaning that if one of the elements of an award is to Swim 5 Metres a student will automatically be issued the distance award when this is achieved. The new 'Linked Awards' feature is optional and can be activated by opening the Location Activity setting (Main menu – Location and Activities – then clicking on the settings icon) and setting the 'Issue Linked Awards via Lesson Manager' setting to 'on'. It should be noted that if a goal is marked as passed then rescinded on the same day the award will be rescinded too. The system will note who issued the award, if the award is purchased, the certificate will be printed with the issuing instructors name on it. In addition to the above changes, we have also created 'Distance', 'I can' and 'Octanauts' matrix awards.



Doing our Bit

With COP26 behind us, we thought it probably easier for us to start to do our little bit for the environment now, rather than waiting for direction from the government. As from 15th November the MOR Solutions team will be working from home 1 day a week, thus reducing our commuting related emission by 20% per week. Over the year we will be making around 100 less business journeys each. The team also decided to try where possible to make 'Green' decisions, the first of which has been to ensure that the office signage we were looking to purchase is made from 'Xanita' (tough cardboard to you and I) instead of vinyl or any other plastic based material, meaning that at the end of its life it can be recycling very easily.

We have also made a conscious effort to ensure all of the prizes for our Christmas Competitions (there are TWO this year – please see below!) are sustainable / eco friendly / recycled. After holding a Facebook vote, it was also decided that we would send Christmas e-cards this year, rather than physical cards, and that we would donate the money usually spent on cards and postage to a swim related charity.
